In the heart of a changing territory

Le Touquet-Paris-Plage is the perfect starting point to discover the assets of a region of great environmental wealth. It is located between two major sites: the Bay de Somme to the south and Les Deux Caps to the north. The Opal coast represents 145 km of diversified coast on most frequented strait of the world which extends from the Authie bay to the Belgian dunes facing England. Our territory includes the major French port of Boulogne-Sur-Mer and a dynamic socio economic fabric.



III YEARS of history

« The city will be born out of light »

1837

Alphonse Daloz acquires land mostly constituted of dune cords. He plants a forest of 800 hectares composed of maritim pines, poplars and alders. It's the perfect setting for a house estate which was the project of his friend Hipppolyte de Villemessant, founder of the well-known French newspaper « Le Figaro ». Their aim is to make this piece of nature become the seaside station of the capital.

« Paris Plage » is born!

1864

Édouard Lévèque, founder of the academic society of Le Touquet and first historian of the station along with Robert de Guyencourt, give to the city a new motto «Fiat Lux, Fiat Urbs» («let there be light, let there be a city». Wink to the lighthouse as well as the Opal Coast referring to the changing light so particular to the region.

1902

John Whitley and Allen Stoneham, owner of the British society « Le Touquet syndicate Ltd » pursue the adventure with a resolutely British spirit. They build many luxury hotels, two casinos, sport facilities....

1912

The seaside station « Paris Plage » finds its definite name that we still know today « Touquet-Paris-Plage ». From then on, the « Perle de la Côte d'Opale » continued to shine in the North of Europe by its elegance and authenticity building and setting up through an exceptional natural and architectural heritage.

2022

Le Touquet-Paris-Plage celebrated during a weekend, the 110 years of culture, heritage, sports and festivities through a varied program of events for all ages.



«So British»

since the beginning

400 beds for officers in the forest casino, whose construction had just been completed.

In the good old days, le Touquet became one of the most elegant stations of the world. The Prince of Wales (future King Edward VIII then Duke of Windsor after his abdication) was a regular visitor. Princes, lords, billionaires, stars...the Duke of Norfolk, Lady Dudley, famous clubs as « Bucks » all rush in the station. During the interwar period, le Touquet has a worldwide reputation.

Aristocracy from all over the world runs into the one that is still called « I'Arcachon du Nord »: the maharajahs, the Aga Khan, Empress from Annam, Morocco Sultan and of course the British gentry. Automotive elegance competitions, polo competitions, the flower festival and the Franco-British celebrations all have a huge success.

The Franco-British relation is very strong.

Le Touquet always had strong links with the United Kingdom. At the end of the 19th century, the enthusiasm for the region of an English businessman led to the creation of Le Touquet Syndicate Limited, which extended the urbanized area, increased the number of facilities and developed activities and hotel occupancy in the emerging resort.

In **1904**, Lord Balfour, Prime Minister of England, inaugurated the golf. Le Touquet's prosperity becomes inseparable to the British presence.

From 1894 to 1913, le Touquet which has a privileged location half way between Paris and London logically becomes the most British station of France. The English had long sought to find a resort close to « the city » which could be at the same time their sports field and their pleasure city. During the First World War, Allen Stoneham, made available the area of le Touquet to the British army: the British red cross and the duchess of Westminster opened a hospital with

1931

The townhall is inaugurated during the Franco-British festivities and one year later, the construction of the covered market is achieved.

The Prince of Wales inaugurated a new club-house and a 18 hole course at the golf.


The name of some villas and hotels are influenced by the British: Royal Picardy hotel, Westminster hotel, « Sunny corner » , « Fair Way », « Rosemary cottage », « The Sandhill » villas (built by Allen Stoneham).

Other villas hosted English personalities as the villa Mad Cap where the Duchess of Westminster was welcomed. Villa Lambins Lalanne hosted the General Mirrlees. cousin of the Queen of England. Edward, Prince of Wales stayed regularly at Villa Rodney Hut. Villa L'escapade hosted the famous writer Somerset Maugham. Villa Blanco was owned by Daniel Sitte, an English industrial. Villa Low Wood sheltered a famous British man of letters named Sir Pelham Grenville Woodhouse. His comedy « Tresor party » was put to screen with Jean-Paul Belmondo as headliner.

Many British celebrities marked le Touquet's history: The Prince of Wales is one of those who by his presence, contributed to the launching of the station. We can also name Lord Balfour. prime minister of England, Marshall Haig commander in chief of the British army during the first world war who lived in villa « North wood », the duke and duchess of Westminster, Winston Churchill, Lord Mountbatten (British admiral's, Last Viceroy of India and First Army Chief of the defence staff), Princess Margaret and Lord Snowdon...

Ian Fleming, father of the James Bond saga was a usual visitor of le Touquet, city where he wrote a part of « Casino Royale », whose action takes place at « Royale les eaux » imaginary city inspired by le Touquet.

From these years, le Touquet has kept the audacity and the eccentricity that makes its charm and singularity which contributes to this image of elegance « **So British** » proper to the station.



1978

The city is twinned to Witney city located at the west of Oxford.

2003

Le Touquet hosted the 25th Franco-British summit in presence of Tony Blair, prime minister of the united Kingdom and Jacques Chirac, President of France.

2022

Le Touquet-Paris-Plage resort welcomes during a unique event, the Royal Air Force and its Red Arrows.

2023

The England Rugby Team chose le Touquet-Paris-Plage as Base Camp during the Rugby World Cup.

Sports Paradise

With quality sports facilities, the resort as always been a true sports paradise.

The **Equestrian park** with its 65 hectares, its equestrian center, its race course and its jumping courts is one of the most beautiful equestrian structures in France and an incredible place for walks with family along the Canche river.

The Nautical Centers of the Canche Bay for sailing and Manche « Bertrand Lambert » for sand yachting. The possibilities to practice nautical sports are multiple: from the age of 8, sand yachting offers unparalleled feelings. A team of qualified instructors propose adapted sessions at every level to discover the joy of steering. It is also possible to set sail with a kayak, a kite surf, a stand up paddle, a surf or a sail which are excellent means to blow off steam while discovering the landscapes of our coast.

The **Tennistic Center** Pierre de Coubertin has 21 clay courts and 5 covered heated courts, 3 outdoor synthetic turf padel courts and an outdoor swimming pool open to all. It also offers a pro shop and a restaurant with terrace and bar.

The **Golf**, located in an exceptional natural environment between dunes and forest is the flagship of golfs on the Opal coast. It offers the preserved heritage of these three exceptional courses.

The **Municipal Sports Center** with its sports hall « Paul Olombel » and the athletics stadium regularly organize competitions and host international teams for their physical preparations.

Le Touquet is also the opportunity to play beach volley on the beach sheltered from the wind. You can also play football on synthetic or grass pitches or field hockey, etc.

The beach of le Touquet-Paris-Plage constitutes a natural jewel along 7 kilometers of fine sand and dune areas, which extend as far as the view from the Canche bay in the north to the nearby resort Stella- Plage in the south.

From spring to autumn, it is the meeting place for the whole family and owes its reputation to the multiple activities offered. Sports competitions, beach clubs, music festivals and various entertainment are at the program for the joy of children and their parents!

The underiable asset of the city is its natural heritage.

In fact, the more than century old **800** hectares of pine, poplars and alder trees, are totally preserved and make this place the perfect setting to discover a rich and endemic fauna and flora diversity. Lined with cycle

paths and dotted with picturesque villas, the Touquet forest is the ideal setting for a resourcing walk. If walking combines the benefits of walking with those of contact with nature, spending time in the forest is always beneficial in all its forms. It is also the dreamed place for family activities that develop your imagination.

Paradise of children ...

Le Touquet-Paris-Plage labelled « Famille Plus » is the paradise for children. They have their own beach clubs and festivals. Here are **4 good reasons** to come with your family to le Touquet-Paris-Plage.

1. Your children will make friends: it's at « The Festival des Tout Petits » (from mid-July to mid-august) or in the beach clubs that from the age of 3, your little holidaymaker will find a fellow builder of sand castles or a trampoline partner.

At the program? Nature workshop, circus, games of yesteryear, sport initiatives and cultural excursions. Long story short, it's the place to be!

2. They want to start a sport's career: it's probably what they will tell you once they finish their training in horseback riding, catamaran, golf, sand yachting, tennis or another emblematic sports of our seaside resort.


A cultural heritage

From the place du Centenaire on the seafront to the Jardin des arts, two steps from the Saint-Jean street, art is everywhere at le Touquet-Paris-Plage. Equipped with a museum of modern and contemporary art nestled in the forest and many galleries, the station inspires painters sculptors, photographers.... since its creation.

A rich heritage

In the roaring twenties, Le Touquet was considered as one of the most beautiful stations of Europe. The city is growing and architects are having a bloom! Villas, hotels, residential and public buildings with clean and geometrical lines or bold forms are built and today testify to a true golden age. 20 buildings are protected as historical monuments in the resort and of these, 18 are listed and 2 are classified (the townhall and the lighthouse).



The lighthouse pride of the city

The story starts in 1846

Two fixed-beam lighthouses were built, then destroyed by the bombings in 1944.

In 1949, Louis Quételart decides to give them a second life by building a new lighthouse (rotating lights), located at the same place, between the two old ones and 800 meters away from the beach. 57 meters high and 274 steps, this breath-taking monument offers a stunning view of the entire station. The lighthouse of the Canche, also named lighthouse of le Touquet, is classified as a historical monument and of course is a must see place.

Guided tours

Discover the exciting history of the resort, its heritage and its wide spaces. As a couple, with friends, with family, on foot or by bike: le Touquet-Paris-Plage has not finished surprising you! The heritage service offers you multiple guided activities adapted to all! And if you prefer more autonomy, find for example the walk around « les Jardins de la Manche », labelled « remarkable gardens ».


Gastronomy and delicacies

2.30 pm, a sheltered afternoon


